The attention of the Commissioner, Panchayat Raj & Rural Employment, Hyderabad is invited to the references cited. She is informed that the process for recruitment of (9355) Junior Panchayat Secretary posts was initiated vide Notification No.2560/CPR&RE/B2/2017, Dt. 30.08.2018 as per Telangana Panchayat Raj, Act 2018. The Written examination was conducted on 10.10.2018 and results were announced on 18.12.2018.

2. In the mean while, the Model Code of Conduct came in force with effect from 24.02.2019 in view of elections to the Legislative Council, and subsequently from 10.03.2019 Model Code of Conduct is in force due to Elections for the Lok Sabha. The appointment orders, therefore, could not be issued and the matter had been referred to the Election Commission of India through Chief Electoral Officer, for their concurrence. The ECI, in their letter Dt. 22.03.2019 has requested that the subject matter attracting Model Code of Conduct must be initially scrutinized by the Screening Committee constituted for the purpose, and if required the matter may be referred to the Commission for consideration with the views/comments of the CEO in the matter.

3. Further the services at Gram Panchayat level, especially in view of summer months, are badly affected as the administration of Panchayat depends on Panchayat Secretaries. Moreover, the services of these employees are needed for forthcoming Mandal Praja Parishad and Zilla Parishad elections also. Hence, there is an urgent need to complete the process of their appointments and postings.

4. In light of the above, and as directed by Election Commission of India, the entire matter has been examined in consultation with the Chief Electoral Officer, State Election Commission and the screening committee. As the voting for Loksabha in the state will be over at 5.00 pm on 11.04.2019, the appointment orders should to be issued to the selected candidates of Junior Panchayat Secretaries immediately after that. By the midnight of 11-12 April, 2019 all Collectors are supposed to send the compliance report of serving appointment letters within their districts.
